## **Recommend Teams Lineup Formats**

## For Ice Allocation

This document is to provide guideline criteria for coaches to ensure the ice allocation policy requirements are achieved for each game.

```
10 Skaters – 4 Defense – 6 Forwards
11 Skaters – 4 Defense – 7 Forwards or 5 Defense – 6 Forward
12 Skaters – 5 Defense – 7 Forwards
13 Skaters – 5 Defense – 8 Forwards
14 Skaters – 6 Defense – 8 Forwards or 5 Defense – 9 Forwards
15 Skaters – 6 Defense – 9 Forwards
16 Skaters – 7 Defense – 9 Forwards or 6 Defense – 10 Forwards
```

17 Skaters – 7 Defense – 10 Forwards

**Note:** It is recommended that if a team has an uneven number of players to accommodate even defense pairs and forward lines the team should be giving each player group (defense or forwards) a number and cycling the players in order throughout the game to provide equitable ice time. It is not recommended for example; 2 forwards centers play with 3 sets of wingers as it is very unlikely the coach will be able to ensure equal ice time throughout the game.

Goalies: are equal play except the Championship Game, play whomever the coach wants
